I-64 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (I-95 to I-64)

Tuesday February 2, 2010

This important project will involve repair and resurfacing of more than five miles of pavement along I-64 east and west between the I-95/I-195 Bryan Park interchange and Parham Road (Exit 181) to include ramps and merge lanes. Concrete repairs started in the fall of 2009. Major asphalt overlay will begin in the spring of 2010 with completion expected by late 2010.

Branscome Inc. of Williamsburg was awarded a contract valued at \$35 million for Interstate 64 pavement rehabilitation in Henrico County. This project will involve concrete repair and asphalt overlay to approximately 5.5 miles of I-64 between the I-95/I-195 interchange and Parham Road. Paving will include the main through lanes, eastbound on and off ramps and 36 additional ramps. Due to the extensive number of travelers in this area (approximately 140,000 daily), temporary lane closures and traffic shifts will take place overnight and on weekends. Completion is anticipated by November 2010.

Keith Rider, P.E. is a 1994 graduate of Pennsylvania State University in Civil Environmental Engineering. Registered Professional Engineer in Virginia and Pennsylvania. Currently the Area Construction Engineer for the Northern Region of the VDOT Richmond District.
