Presented by Kathleen R. Nobsch**

The Commonwealth of Virginia has implemented new regulations which require all Architects, Professional Engineers, and Land Surveyors to earn continuing education credits. Our program for August will be a presentation by Kathleen R. Nobsch on these new APELSCIDLA Continuing Education regulations. Ms. Nobsch's presentation will also include a brief history of the APELSCIDLA Board, a review of the Board website, and an overview of licensing issues and disciplinary actions. She will discuss the Who, What, When and Why of Continuing Education and will be available to address questions and concerns.

Ms. Nobsch is Executive Director for the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects (APELSCIDLA) as well as the Auctioneers Board, Boards for Branch Pilots, Soil Scientists and Wetland Professionals, and the Board for Professional and Occupational Regulation under the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR). Prior to her current position, Ms. Nobsch was the Deputy Executive Director for the Virginia Board of Medicine under the Department of Health Professions for eight years. Ms. Nobsch is the immediate past president of the Council on Licensure, Enforcement and Regulation (CLEAR) and has served on the board since 2003. She is a current member of the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards' Member Board Executive Committee and a former Southern Region Representative on the board for Administrators in Medicine (AIM). She holds a B.A. in Business/Communication and a M.S. in Professional Leadership with a concentration in training and development from Carlow University in Pittsburgh.
