**TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT PLAN  
REQUIREMENTS AND WORK ZONE SAFETY**

This presentation will focus on the FHWA's Final Rule on Work Zone Safety and Mobility, which applies to State and local governments that receive Federal-aid highway funding.

VDOT has addressed this Federal rule in the published Instructional and Informational Memorandum LD-241 & TED-351 that establishes the requirements in a Transportation Management Plan (TMP). Paul will lead us through the details of this memorandum leaving no question unanswered.

The three work zone strategies: Temporary Traffic Control, Public Communication and Transportation Operations will be explained. How these strategies are implemented at each of the project milestones will be reviewed along with the responsibilities of each team member.

A tool used by project managers places projects into categories based on the level of complexity. Once we have the category, the type of transportation management, A, B or C, is defined and the minimum TMP requirements can be followed.

**Paul Kelley** is currently a Work Zone Safety Coordinator with the Virginia Department of Transportation. His primary responsibility in this position is to develop and implement the guidance on work safety and mobility to meet the requirements of the new Federal rule. Prior to his current position with the Department, Paul spent 11 years in the Engineering Services Section of the Location & Design Division managing the Standards/Special Design and the Policy & Procedures Work Groups.
