Jack Rollison, III and Richard D. Daugherty III, CAE
Give a recap of the General Assembly
Thursday March 10, 2005

Transportation is always on the front burner during the General Assembly session and this year is no exception. Which of the dozens of bills and resolutions will be passed and what do they mean for the highway industry? And the big question: how much of the unexpected budget surplus will be spent on Transportation? The American Society of Highway Engineers is delighted to have two authorities that know the intricacies of the General Assembly speak to us during our March meeting.

John "Jack" Rollison is Special Assistant to VDOT Commissioner Shucet and previously served in the General Assembly for 17 years, including acting as chair and co-chair of the House Transportation Committee. Mr. Rollison reports directly to the commissioner in the areas of urban congestion relief, federal reauthorization legislation, and community outreach.

Dick Daugherty is the Executive Director of the Virginia Transportation Construction Alliance (formerly the Virginia Road and Transportation Builders Association where he served as Executive Vice President in the role of Top Officer and Chief Lobbyist). The VTCA organization is dedicated to serving the specific needs of businesses involved in Virginia's transportation construction industry. The VTCA serves contractors, materials suppliers, consulting engineers and other professional service firms.

Please plan to join your colleagues as Mr. Rollison and Mr. Daugherty provide a recap of the current General Assembly session: what was accomplished and what still needs to be done for the future of Virginia's transportation system.
