Low Impact Development (LID)  
Thursday May 11, 2006

Mr. Street is the appointed director for the City of Fredericksburg, Tri-County/City SWCD. He has over 25 years experience in the planning and engineer design field and his various positions have helped to understand the many aspects of site development designs to include environmentally friendly designs to help re-establish the original ecosystem through Low Impact Development (LID).

There are many definitions and each state is creating their own unique perspective. The EPA most recently is directing and forcing LID to become portions of new designs for not only development but most recently FHWA has agreed to insert LID's BMP/IMP (Best Management Practice/Integrated Management Practice) in any and all transportation projects. The USACoE is writing and requiring an LID portion for each of their permits. Before anyone can use LID they need a basic understanding of what LID is attempting to do.

LID was developed to allow no increase of storm-water to leave a site. This presentation will show how LID principals and practices can be incorporated into the linear thought pattern. Attendees will have a better understanding of LID principals and how existing approved practice/measures can be included into any transportation project. These practices are also cost effective and will not drastically impact existing maintenance of any transportation facility.
