Mr. Ramsey currently serves as principal and senior regulatory specialist at the Williamsburg Environmental Group, Inc. His primary area of specialization is regulatory support, which incorporates his knowledge of aquatic and wetland ecology and his experience in working with Local, State and Federal agencies. Mr. Ramsey has assessed numerous proposed construction project impacts on the aquatic environment, including wetlands, from the perspective of an applicant and as a regulator.

Prior to his current employment, Mr. Ramsey worked as an Environmental Scientist & Project Manager with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and as an Environmental Program Analyst with the Virginia Department of Transportation.

Mr. Ramsey received his B.S. in Environmental Science from Ferrum College and is certified as a Professional Wetland Scientist (PWS) by the Society of Wetland Scientists.
